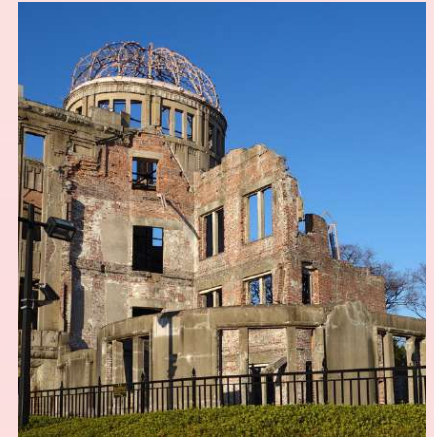

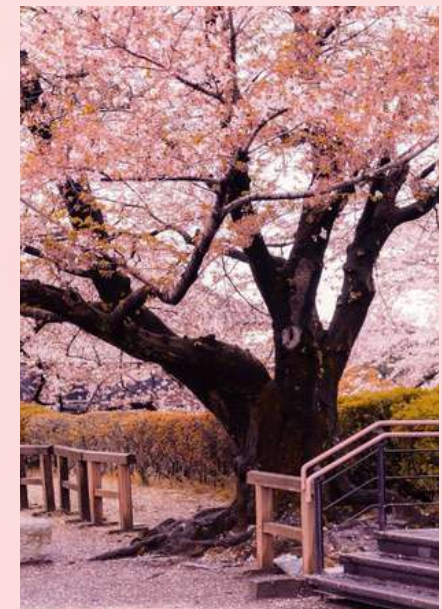

2. Age criteria: Participants must be under 85 years old.
3. For the Japan trip, punctuality is crucial; please be on time.
4. Activities may change based on weather conditions without prior notice.
5. Purchase SIM cards or activate international roaming at the airport; communication will be through WhatsApp.
6. Ensure you have enough JPY/Yens; currency won't be provided in Japan.
7. Mandatory travel documents: Original passport with at least 6 months validity from the tour arrival date and sufficient blank pages for visa stamping.
8. Tour includes 1.5~2 hours of walking on sightseeing days. Participants should have moderate fitness, keep up with the group's pace, and handle stairs comfortably.
9. Hiroshima trip involves adventure walking using metro trains, bullet trains, and trams as needed.
